Human Performance & Limitations / Air Law
Operational Procedures / Meteorology / Communications

Total exams taken = 82 Total exams passed = 75



91% of all exams were passed which is well above the industry average. Congratulations to students and instructors.

2. Airbus A320 simulator available for PRO-PILOT Phase Three

From this April for Phase Three training in Cambridge there will be a new option. VA Airline Training will also be offering the same APS MCC course of training, currently on a B737, on an Airbus A-320 advanced MPS platform. Prior to training commencement, all you need to do is indicate which of the two devices you prefer and you will be scheduled accordingly.
