## THE PROGRAMME

- Duration: **16 months**

- Frequency: **twice per month** (except for January & December when there is **one** programme per month)
- Total flying hours **219** hours
- Total Theoretical hours **750** hours
- Buzz multi-engine hours **50+** hours
- APS MCC & A-UPRT **43** hours
- Flight Training Simulator Device **24** hours

## WHAT IS INCLUDED

- All ground, simulator and flight training is according to **minimum** hours syllabus
- 16 months shared **accommodation**
- Experience flying up to **8 aircraft types**
- Up to 50 hours multi-engine with **Buzz Airlines**
- **APS MCC & A-UPRT** with Airline Flight Academy
- **Mentoring** during training from a commercial pilot plus airline recommendations afterwards

## PRE-ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Be able to read, write and understand **English**
- Successfully complete the **2FLY Skills Assessment**
