

Why a Dual Licence?

The UK leaving the European Union (EU) created some challenges within flight crew licensing. When part of the EU, a UK CAA issued licence was recognised by the EU but since Brexit, it is not. The UK CAA and EASA are now completely separate entities. To fly European registered aircraft and work for one of the hundreds of European airlines, you require both a visa to work in Europe and an EASA licence. The alternative is to obtain a UK CAA licence which restricts you to just those airlines registered in the UK (such as British Airways, Ryanair, Jet2 and Easyjet).

Whether the UK CAA and EASA eventually bridge their differences and cooperate more closely is not clear. In the meantime, we recommend students put themselves in the best possible position to maximise their recruitment opportunities. Accordingly, 2FLY's flagship programme is the Dual Licence Pro-Pilot Airline Programme where you obtain both UK CAA and EASA 'frozen' ATPL Licenses with the aim of maximising your job opportunities.

Three Phases

The training for your licences will involve completing **foundation training** at our fair-weather base in the USA, followed by **advanced training** in all weathers in the UK, culminating in **jet training** in the Republic of Ireland:
